

Millennium Falcon Table

Assembly instructions

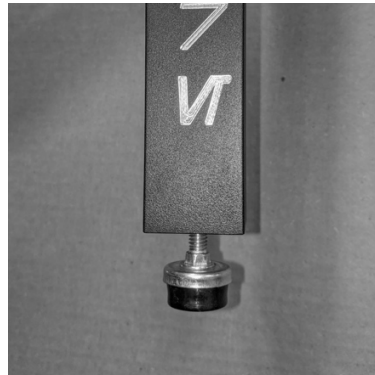
Step 1

Screw glass support (4) into top of each leg.
(Note – each leg has a hole in the top and bottom. They are different diameters, so you'll figure out which end is the top.)



Step 2

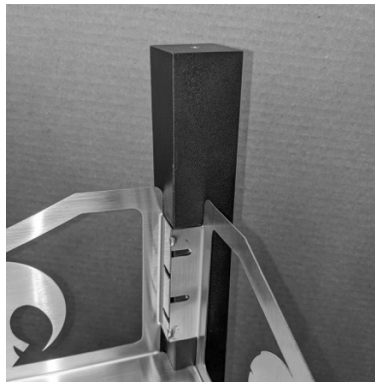
Screw foot (4) into the bottom each leg.
(Note – use the hole you didn't use in Step 1.)



Step 3

(Note: having someone to help you hold the parts will be of great help. You can do it alone, but I wouldn't advise it!)

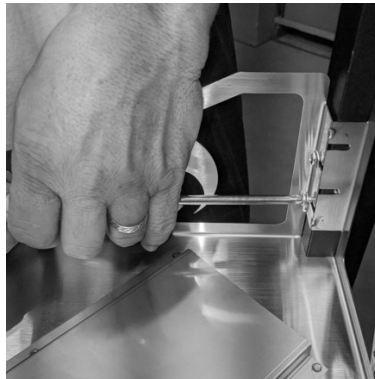
With the leg and table base upside-down, line up four slots with four holes in leg



Step 4

Attach leg and base with four screws in each leg. Do not fully tighten the screws until all four screws are in place.

(See why I recommended that you get someone to help you?)



Step 5

If you followed these lengthy and extremely difficult steps, this is what each leg should look like. If not, go back to step 1.



Step 6

Once you receive your glass, carefully slide each piece in the side slots. There will be a little play in the fit to allow for variances in the glass size.

Next line up the top glass and lower onto the four legs. The suction cups in the glass support will secure the top.

Suggestion: Install two sides and then place your LEGO display. After that, install the remaining sides and top.

Last piece of advice. Don't plan on moving the table unless you completely remove all glass pieces.
